What are voles?

- Voles, unlike moles, are rodents.
- They look similar to mice but have a shorter tail and smaller ears that sit close to the head.
- There are 2 types of voles in the Triangle:
 Pine Voles and Meadow Voles.

Voles and Your Lawn:

- Both species of vole can cause damage to your plants and lawn.
- Voles are **herbivorous**, consuming the roots of your plants and even bark from young trees.
- Voles are active **year round.**
- Pine voles live and travel underground while meadow voles spend most of their lives above ground.
- The underground tunnels (or runs) are typically found along house foundations, garden walls, and vegetation.
- Voles are prolific breeders: a female vole can **produce 2-5 young every 2 months.**
 - Those young reach sexual maturity after 30 days and can produce another 2-5 pups each.
 - That's a lot of voles that can quickly overwhelm your property!
